**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING**  
**NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the April 12, 2022 application of CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC and North Orange Water & Sewer, LLC for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Orange County. On April 27 and May 9, 2022, the applicants filed supplemental information.

On May 12, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding completeness of the application and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in and attached to Patricia Garcia's May 12, 2022 memorandum, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:
