ORDER NO. 5 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ADOPTING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of notice of Gideon Water, LLC's application to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County.

On June 23, 2022, Gideon Water filed a publisher's affidavit attesting to the publication of notice in the *Houston Chronicle dba Cypress Creek Mirror*, a newspaper of general circulation in Montgomery County, on May 18 and 25, 2022. On August 4, 2022, Gideon Water filed the affidavits of Shelley Young, P.E., Gideon Water's authorized representative, attesting that notice of the application was mailed to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on May 18, 2022.

On September 1, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.
