**COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

**I. INTRODUCTION**

On April 12, 2022, Gideon Water LLC (Gideon Water) filed an application to obtain a Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County. The requested service area consists of 79 acres. Gideon Water filed supplemental information on April 13 and May 4, 2022.

On September 2, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, requiring the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application by October 31, 2022.

**II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to file a final recommendation on the application in order to allow additional time to prepare and review the tariff. Accordingly, Staff requests that its deadline to file a final recommendation on the application be extended to November 14, 2022.

**III. CONCLUSION**

For the reason discussed above, Staff requests that its deadline to file a final recommendation on the application be extended to November 14, 2022.
