COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

I. INTRODUCTION

On April 12, 2022, Gideon Water LLC (Gideon Water) filed an application to obtain a Water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County. The requested service area consists of 79 acres.

On November 17, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 7, directing the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a final recommendation on the application by December 7, 2022. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Pursuant to 16 TAC § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for the filing of any documents be extended for good cause. The signed consent forms have not yet been filed in this docket. Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests an extension of time until December 19, 2022 for Gideon Water to file signed consent forms, the Commission Staff's deadline to file a final recommendation on the application until January 3, 2023, and the deadline for the parties to file joint proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law until January 17, 2023.

III. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending the deadlines as described above.
