**ORDER NO. 2
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the administrative completeness of the April 12, 2022 application of Gideon Water, LLC to obtain a water certificate of convenience and necessity in Montgomery County.

On May 12, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness and proposed a procedural schedule.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the petitioners to provide notice of the application as described in the May 12, 2022 memorandum of Jolie Mathis attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for applicant to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	June 24, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	July 5, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after last date notice is issued
