- **RESPONSE** The "Aid to Construction Fee," also known as an Equity Buy-In Fee, is assessed per the Tariff, (in addition to the Membership Fee) on each new member/applicant for new service that requires a new service tap to achieve parity with the contributions to the construction or acquisition of Parker WSC's assets related to capacity that has been made previously by existing Parker WSC members. Such fees are common in the industry and included in Texas Rural Water Association's sample tariff.

Parker WSC does not have records available to divide the Aid to Construction Fee into Labor, Material, or Equipment costs.
