**ORDER NO. 2**  
**FINDING APPLICATION INCOMPLETE AND DEFICIENT AND**  
**ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the April 14, 2022 application of Rio Concho Aviation Inc. for a class D rate adjustment for its public water system PWS#2200330, under certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 12835. On May 16, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation that the application be found deficient and that Rio Concho have an opportunity to cure the deficiencies.

The administrative law judge deems the application administratively incomplete and deficient. By May 30, 2022, Rio Concho must file the additional information to cure the deficiencies as described in the May 16, 2022 memorandum of James Onyeneke. Commission Staff is encouraged to work with Rio Concho to cure the deficiencies. By June 13, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
