**REQUIRING COMMISSION STAFF APPRAISER'S REPORT**

In Order No. 2 filed on May 26, 2022, the administrative law judge established a deadline for Commission Staff's appraiser's report within 100 days after the Commission approves streamlined expedited release. The Commission Order approving the streamlined expedited release was filed on October 6, 2022, therefore Commission Staff's appraiser report was due January 17, 2023.<sup>1</sup>

By February 8, 2023, Commission Staff must file its appraiser's report.
