COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On April 21, 2022, Maple View Development, LLC (MPD) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from Orbit Systems, Inc.'s (Orbit) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 11982 in Brazoria County under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). MPD asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Brazoria County, which is a qualifying county.

On May 23, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 2, establishing a deadline of July 20, 2022, for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

In accordance with 16 TAC § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to review MPD's supplemental filing.¹ Accordingly, Staff respectfully requests that its deadline to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice be extended to August 5, 2022. Staff has conferred with MPD who have indicated they are unopposed to the extension.

II. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully requests that its deadline to file a supplemental recommendation on the administrative completeness of the petition and notice be extended to August 5, 2022.
