ORDER NO. 3 GRANTING EXTENSION AND REVISING DEADLINES

This Order addresses Commission Staff's July 18, 2022 request to extend the time to file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the petition and sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule. Commission Staff states that additional time is needed to review Maple View's supplemental filing. Commission Staff represents that Maple View is not opposed to the extension.

The administrative law judge grants Commission Staff's request for extension. By August 5, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness of the petition and sufficiency of notice and propose procedural schedule.

A deadline for Orbit Systems to file a response to the petition will be established in a subsequent order.¹ Additional deadlines will be established if the petition is deemed administratively complete.
