FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT,
ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING DOCKET

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice of this application provided by Amberwood Utility Co. and CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC. On July 14, 2022, the applicants filed an affidavit of notice to current customers, neighboring utilities, and affected parties on July 14, 2022, as well as the required maps.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule is established for continued processing.

Deadline for parties to file a joint motion to admit evidence and proposed order approving sale and allowing transaction to proceed.	October 24, 2022
120-day deadline for the Commission to approve the sale or require a hearing	November 14, 2022 ²

¹ Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.239(b), the intervention period shall not be less than 30 days unless good cause is shown. Notice was mailed on July 14, 2022. Thirty days after July 14, 2022, is August 13, 2022. Because August 13, 2022, is a Saturday, a day in which the Commission was closed, under 16 TAC § 22.4(a), the deadline is the next day the Commission is open for business, Monday, August 15, 2022.

² Under 16 TAC § 24.239(a) and (i), the deadline for Commission action is one hundred twenty (120) days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. One hundred and twenty days after July 14, 2022 is November 11, 2022. November 11, 2022, is Veteran's Day, a day on which the Commission is closed. Therefore, under 16 TAC § 22.4(a), the deadline is the next day the Commission is open for business, Monday, November 14, 2022.

Further Commission Staff requests to restyle the docket to add the missing abbreviation “Co.” to the end Amberwood Utility.

The ALJ grants the request to restyle the docket as reflected in this Order
