Docket No. 53540; SOAH Docket No. 473-22-2604 – *Application of Southwestern Public Service Company to Adjust its Energy Efficiency Cost Recovery Factor*

A proposed order filed in the above-referenced docket is posted for consideration and action by the Commission. If the Commission approves the proposed order, I recommend the following changes to the Commission's order.

Finding of fact 14 should be modified for clarity.

14. On June 17, 2022, Commission Staff filed its final recommendation, which was titled a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice and of the application. Commission Staff attached the memoranda of James Harville of the Commission's Infrastructure Division, and Charles Rudolph and Frederick Quijano of the Commission's Rate Regulation Division, in support of its final recommendation of approval of SWEPCO's application.

Finding of fact 32 should be modified to remove language that is more appropriate in a conclusion of law and is already included in conclusion of law 33.

32. The affiliate expenses included in SPS's EECRF rates approved in this Order are reasonable and necessary ~~and comply with PURA³ § 36.058 and~~

Additionally, the Commission should delegate to the Office of Policy and Docket Management the authority to modify the order to conform to the *Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas* and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.

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
