COMMISSION STAFF'S SUPPLEMENTAL RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

I. BACKGROUND

On May 4, 2022, Benchmark Acquisitions, LLC (Benchmark) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from MSEC Enterprises Inc.'s (MSEC) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 12887 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Benchmark asserts that the land to be released is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Montgomery County, which is a qualifying county. Benchmark filed supplemental information on July 5, 2022.

On August 10, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 4, establishing a deadline of September 20, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to file a recommendation on final disposition. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

II. RECOMMENDATION ON FINAL DISPOSITION

Staff has reviewed the supplemented petition and as detailed in the attached memorandum from Jolie Mathis, Infrastructure Division, recommends that the petition satisfies the requirements of TWC § 13.2541 and 16 TAC § 24.245(h). MSEC submitted an affidavit signed by Troy Morris indicating that they do not object to the petition. Accordingly, Staff recommends that the petition for streamlined expedited release be approved. Further, the final water CCN map and certificate are attached to this filing. Staff recommends that the final map and certificate be provided to Benchmark and for Benchmark to file a certified copy of the CCN map and a boundary description of the CCN service area in the Montgomery County Clerk's office, as required under TWC § 13.257(r)-(s).

III. CONCLUSION

For the reasons detailed above, Staff respectfully recommends that the petition be approved and respectfully requests the entry of an order consistent with the foregoing recommendations.

County by Streamlined Expedited Release

On May 4, 2022, Benchmark Acquisitions, LLC (Benchmark) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from MSEC Enterprises, Inc.'s (MSEC) water Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCN) No. 12887 in Montgomery County, under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541(b) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Benchmark asserts that the land is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Montgomery County, which is a qualifying county.

Benchmark provided a warranty deed confirming ownership of the tract of land within MSEC's certificated service area. In addition, Benchmark submitted a sworn affidavit attesting that the tract of land was not receiving water service from the CCN holder. MSEC submitted an affidavit signed by Troy Morris indicating that they do not object to the petition.

Based on the mapping review by Hank Journeay, Infrastructure Division, it was determined the landowner's total property is approximately 389 acres. The tract of land in the petition for streamlined expedited release is approximately 4.8 acres, of which approximately 4.6 acres overlap MSEC (CCN No. 12887) and would be decertified from CCN No. 12887.

In accordance with TWC § 13.2541 and 16 TAC § 24.245(h), Benchmark has met the Commission's requirements to allow for the release of the tract of land from MSEC's CCN No. 12887. Therefore, I recommend approval of the petition.

Enclosed is a final map and certificate for Commission approval.






Water CCN
