**COMMISSION STAFF'S REVISED FINAL MAP**

**I. BACKGROUND**

On May 4, 2022, Benchmark Acquisitions, LLC (Benchmark) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from MSEC Enterprises Inc.'s (MSEC) water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 12887 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Benchmark asserts that the land to be released is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Montgomery County, which is a qualifying county. Benchmark filed supplemental information on July 5, 2022.

On September 23, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 5, establishing a deadline of October 7, 2022 for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission (Commission) to file a recommendation on final disposition. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

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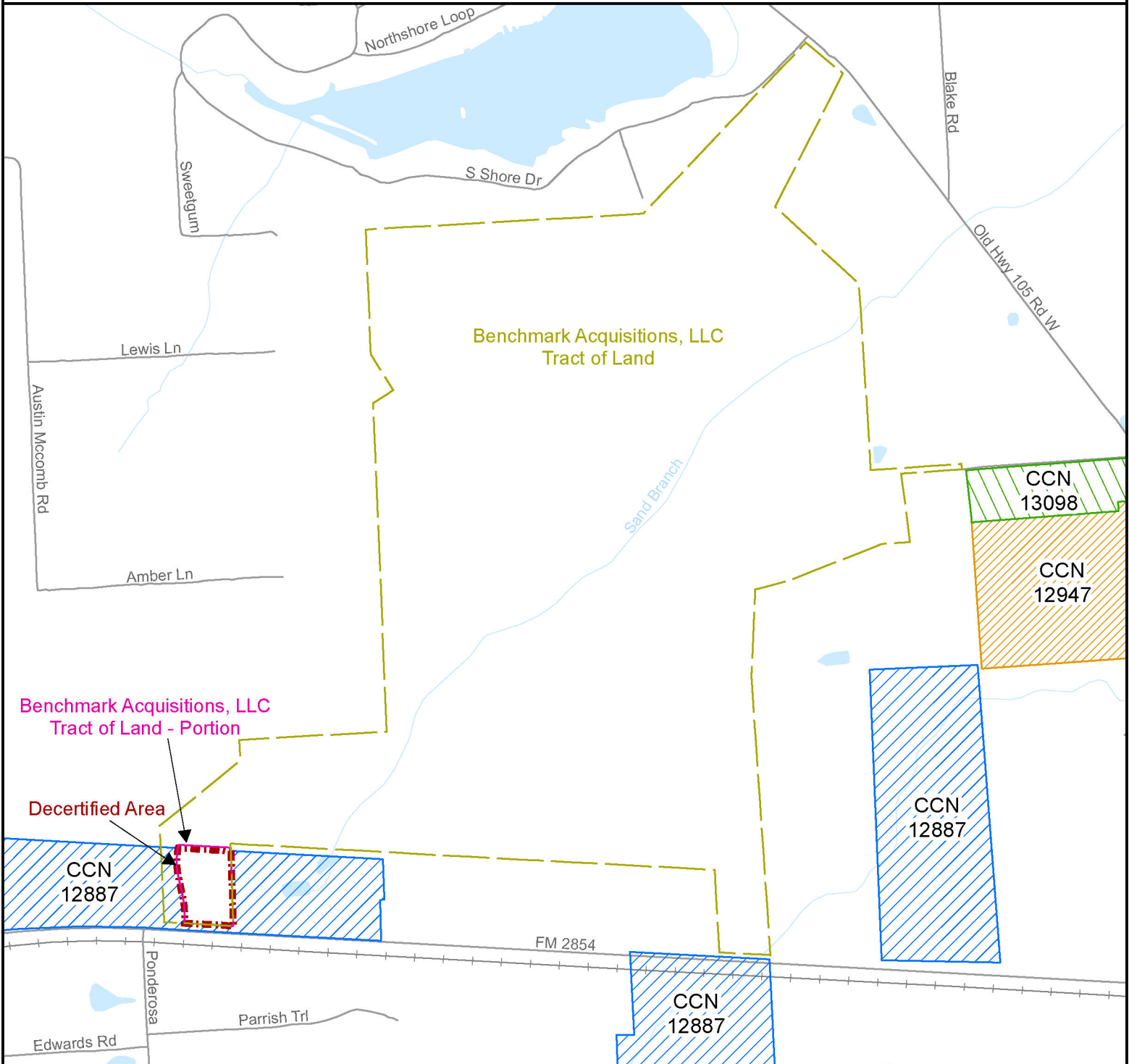

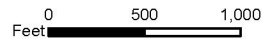
