COMMISSION STAFF'S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

On May 4, 2022, Benchmark Acquisitions, LLC (Benchmark) filed a petition for streamlined expedited release from MSEC Enterprises Inc.'s water certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) number 12887 under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541 and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.245(h). Benchmark asserts that the land to be released is at least 25 contiguous acres, is not receiving water service, and is located in Montgomery County, which is a qualifying county.

On May 5, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) filed Order No. 1, establishing a deadline of June 3, 2022 for the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff) to file comments regarding the administrative completeness of the petition and notice. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.

I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 22.4(b), Staff may request that the time allowed for filing any documents be extended for good cause. Staff requires additional time to review the information. Accordingly, Staff requests that the deadline to file comments on the administrative completeness of the application and proposed notice by be extended to June 10, 2022.

II. CONCLUSION

Staff respectfully requests an order consistent with the foregoing request.
