ORDER NO. 4 FINDING PETITION, AS SUPPLEMENTED, ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE AND NOTICE SUFFICIENT, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the May 4, 2022 petition of Benchmark Acquisitions, LLC to amend MSEC Enterprises Inc.'s certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) in Montgomery County by streamlined expedited release. On July 5, 2022, Benchmark filed a supplement to the petition.

I. Finding Petition, as Supplemented, Administratively Complete

On August 10, 2022, Commission Staff recommended that the petition, as supplemented, be found administratively complete. The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the petition, as supplemented, administratively complete. The finding of administrative completeness does not address the merits of the petition.

II. Finding Notice Sufficient

On May 4, 2022, Benchmark provided in the application's certificate of service a statement that it mailed a copy of its petition to the CCN holder, MSEC, by certified mail, return receipt requested on the day the petition was filed with the Commission. Benchmark also included an affidavit attesting to this provision of notice to MSEC. The ALJ finds the notice sufficient.

III. Establishing Procedural Schedule

Under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.2541, the granting of streamlined expedited release initiates an appraisal process to determine the amount of monetary compensation that may be owed by the landowner to the certificate holder for the tract of land that was released. Therefore, an order granting approval for streamlined expedited release is interim in nature and, in the event the

requested release is approved, the docket will continue for the purpose of determining the issue of compensation.
