A proposed order in the above-referenced docket is posted for consideration and action by the Commission. If the Commission approves the proposed order, I recommend the following changes.

New finding of fact 9 should be added for completeness.

9. On August 22, 2022, the petitioner sent a copy of the amended petition by email to the CCN holder.

New conclusions of law 9 and 11 should be added for clarity.

- 9. The petitioner's tract of land in Montgomery County that is approximately
 154.8 acres constitutes a single tract of land under TWC § 13.2541 because
 it has common ownership and is contiguous.
- 11. The petitioner's request for streamlined expedited release of approximately 22.5 acres within the CCN holder's certificated service area satisfies the

TWC 25-acre minimum requirement for expedited release of an area from a CCN because it is part of a tract of land that is at least 25 acres.

Additionally, the Commission should delegate to the Office of Policy and Docket Management the authority to modify the order to conform to the Citation and Style Guide for the Public Utility Commission of Texas and to make other non-substantive changes to the order for such matters as capitalization, spelling, grammar, punctuation, style, correction of numbering, and readability.
