There were no restrictions placed on transmission-level customers by Oncor that controlled the individual facilities that were permitted to operate or the hours of their operations. Oncor is not aware of any restrictions that were placed on transmission-level customers by ERCOT that controlled the individual facilities that were permitted to operate or the hours of their operations. ERCOT issued an appeal to the public to voluntarily conserve energy on February 14, 2021, and Oncor extended this energy conservation appeal to all of its customers on February 15, 2021 to voluntarily reduce loads to the extent possible.
