**FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT**  
**AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the June 20, 2024 notice of completed transaction filed by Orbit Systems, Inc. and Undine Texas, LLC.

On July 8, 2024, Commission Staff recommended that the closing documentation be found sufficient, that customer deposits have been adequately addressed, and proposed a procedural schedule for continued processing.

The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation sufficient and customer deposits adequately addressed.
