**ORDER NO. 35
REQUIRING CLARIFICATION AND SETTING
DEADLINE TO REQUEST A HEARING**

In Order No. 4 filed on August 10, 2022, the administrative law judge (ALJ) granted Tommy Green’s motion to intervene. On August 9, 2024, Orbit Systems, Inc., Undine Texas Environmental, LLC, and Commission Staff filed a joint motion to admit supplemental evidence and proposed notice of approval. In the joint motion, Orbit, Undine, and Commission Staff state that they are the parties to this proceeding.¹ Orbit, Undine, and Commission Staff are aware that Mr. Green is also a party, as the ALJ already required a clarification regarding whether they involved Mr. Green in the preparation of the proposed order granting sale, transfer, or merger.²

By October 21, 2024, Orbit, Undine, and Commission Staff must clarify whether they conferred with Mr. Green prior to the filing of the joint motion to admit additional evidence and proposed notice of approval and whether Mr. Green was involved with the preparation of the proposed notice of approval.

Additionally, the ALJ establishes October 25, 2024, as the deadline for Mr. Green to request a hearing.
