**ORDER NO. 3  
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING  
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the May 23, 2022 application of Orbit Systems, Inc. and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Brazoria County. Undine Texas filed supplements to the application on May 25 and June 21, 2022.

On July 20, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding completeness of the application and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in Patricia Garcia's July 20, 2022 memorandum, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	August 29, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
