





APPLICATION AND PRELIMINARY DECISION. Blue Cube Operations LLC, 604 Highway 332, Lake Jackson, TX 77566-6101, has applied to the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for an amendment to Air Quality Permit Number 48479, which would authorize modification to a Perchloroethylene Storage & Loading Facility located at 2301 N Brazosport Blvd, Freeport, Brazoria County, Texas 77541. This application was submitted to the TCEQ on October 27, 2021. The amendment will authorize an increase in emissions of the following air contaminants: carbon monoxide, hazardous air pollutants, nitrogen oxides, and particulate matter including particulate matter with diameters of 10 microns or less and 2.5 microns or less.

The executive director has completed the technical review of the application and prepared a draft permit which, if approved, would establish the conditions under which the facility must operate. The executive director has made a preliminary decision to issue the permit because it meets all rules and regulations. The permit application, executive director's preliminary decision, and draft permit will be available for viewing and copying at the TCEQ central office, the TCEQ Houston regional office, and at the Brazoria County Library System – Lake Jackson Branch, 250 Circle Way, Lake Jackson, Brazoria County, Texas, beginning the first day of publication of this notice. The facility's compliance file, if any exists, is available for public review at the TCEQ Houston Regional Office, 5425 Polk St Ste H, Houston, Texas.

PUBLIC COMMENT/PUBLIC MEETING. You may submit public comments or request a public meeting about this application. The purpose of a public meeting is to provide the opportunity to submit comment or to ask questions about the application. The TCEQ will hold a public meeting if the executive director determines that there is a significant degree of public interest in the application or if requested by a local legislator. A public meeting is not a contested case hearing.
