**APPLICANT’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On December 28, 2022, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 12 requiring that Undine issue revised notice of the application by February 3, 2023, and file proof of the revised notice by February 17, 2023. And on January 18, 2023, the ALJ issued Order No. 18 requiring that parties to file clarification on certain issues by February 3, 2023.

Undine hereby requests two-week extensions to February 17, 2023 to file clarification and issue revised notice, and to March 3, 2023, to file proof of the revised notice. Undine has been working diligently with Staff to address some of the issues the ALJ wanted clarified and needs additional time before submitting the required clarifications. In addition, Undine requires additional time beyond the identified February 3, 2023 date to meet publication deadlines for the revised notice. Undine is not requesting this extension for purposes of delay. Undine has conferred with Staff and is authorized to represent they are unopposed to the proposed extensions.
