ORDER NO. 16 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND SOLICITING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Orbit Systems, Inc. and Undine Texas Environmental, LLC of this application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Brazoria County.

On February 22, 2023, Undine filed the affidavit of Carey Thomas, senior vice president of Undine, attesting that notice was provided to its current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties, on February 15, 2023, as well as the maps that were attached to the provided notice.

On March 7, 2023, Undine filed a publisher's affidavit attesting that notice was published in *The Facts*, a newspaper of general circulation in Brazoria County, on February 14 and 21, 2023.

On March 10, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

By March 20, 2023, Commission Staff must provide a procedural schedule for continued processing of this application.
