ORDER NO. 18 REQUIRING CLARIFICATION ON NOTICE

On February 22, 2023, Undine Texas Environmental, LLC filed an affidavit attesting that notice was provided to current customers, landowners, and affected parties. It confidentially attached a list of recipients with names and mailing addresses.

On March 7, 2023, Undine Texas Environmental filed proof of publication of notice.

In light of Commissioner Jackson's memorandum in Docket No. 51651,¹ the administrative law judge requires Undine Texas Environmental to confirm by affidavit that notice has been mailed by first class mail to each owner of a tract of land that is at least 25 acres and is wholly or partially included in the area proposed to be certified according to the most current tax appraisal rolls of the applicable central appraisal district at the time the Commission received the application for the amendment. Proof of notice that includes the names and mailing address, but does not identify which tracts of land in the requested area are at least 25 acres and who owns those tracts of land is not sufficient evidence of notice, as required under Texas Water Code (TWC) § 13.246(a-1) and 16 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 24.235(b)(2).² The evidentiary record must show which tracts of land in the requested area are at least 25 acres and who owns those tracts.³

By May 31, 2023, Undine Texas Environmental must file (1) an affidavit that notice has been mailed by first class mail to each owner of a tract of land that is at least 25 acres and is wholly

or partially included in the area proposed to be certified according to the most current tax appraisal rolls of the applicable central appraisal district at the time the Commission received the application and (2) evidence showing which tracts of land in the requested area are at least 25 acres and who owns those tracts.

The deadlines established in Order No. 17 remain in effect.
