**ORDER NO. 5
REQUIRING CLARIFICATION**

This Order addresses the May 23, 2022 application of Monarch Utilities I L.P. for a certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) name change and a minor tariff change.

On August 4, 2022, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on administrative completeness, proposed notice, and proposed a procedural schedule.

By August 26, 2022, the parties must file clarification on the following issues:

1. The statutes and Commission rules governing a CCN name change;
2. The statutes and Commission rules governing changes to a utility's application for service; and
3. The proper processing of Monarch's application in light of Patricia Garcia's July 29, 2022 memorandum, which states:

Appendix B of the tariff is a separate part of the tariff which is not approved by the Commission. The tariff filed with the Commission should only contain the cover pages for the appendices. The appendices are meant to be attached to the tariff by the utility when requested by a customer as they are not approved by the Commission. . . . On the issue with the minor tariff change I do not think it needs to be considered.”¹
