AGREED MOTION TO ABATE

COMES NOW, the Cities Served by Texas-New Mexico Power Company (Cities) with the consent and approval of Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Staff), the Alliance for Retail Marketers (ARM), and Texas Energy Association for Marketers (TEAM) (collectively, the Parties), and files this Agreed Motion to Abate the proceeding. As of the time of this filing, Cities has not heard from Texas-New Mexico Power Company (TNMP) regarding whether they can agree to this motion.

The Parties are having ongoing settlement discussions in this matter, and are close to reaching an agreement in principle. However, the Parties need additional time to finish finalizing settlement terms. Accordingly, the Parties request that the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) abate all pending settings and deadlines for one week.

The Parties further agree to file either a settlement stipulation or a status report, on or before July 28, 2022.

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Parties request that the ALJ abate this proceeding, and grant the Parties such further and other relief to which they may be entitled.




