GRANTING MOTION TO ABATE**

On July 21, 2022, the Cities Served by Texas-New Mexico Power Company (Cities) filed a motion to abate, stating that the parties are close to reaching an agreement in principle and need time to finish finalizing settlement terms. Cities represents that the Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Texas, the Alliance for Retail Marketers, and Texas Energy Association for Marketers agree with the motion, and that they had received a response from Texas-New-Mexico Power Company regarding its position on the motion. As of July 22, 2022, no objection had been filed.

Accordingly, the motion to abate is **GRANTED**. No later than **July 28, 2022**, the parties **SHALL** file either a settlement stipulation or a status report.
