**ORDER NO. 28**  
**FINDING CLOSING DOCUMENTATION SUFFICIENT**  
**AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the closing documentation filed by Clearwater Operating Services, LLC and Knob Hill Water System, on May 21, 2024 and supplemented on June 5 and 14, 2024. The closing documents include a purchase agreement with an effective date of April 4, 2024, signed by representative of Clearwater and Knob Hill. Additionally, the applicants state that there are no customer deposits to be addressed.

On June 17, 2024, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on the sufficiency of the closing documents and proposed procedural schedule.


The administrative law judge finds the closing documentation sufficient.
