## ORDER NO. 3 FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Clearwater Investments LLC and Knob Hill Water System. On August 8, 2022, applicants filed proof of notice, along with map, that was provided to current customers, neighboring utilities and systems, and affected parties on August 4, 2022. On August 11, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the notice.

The administrative law judge finds the notice sufficient.

The following procedural schedule is established for continued processing.

 $<sup>^2</sup>$  Under 16 TAC § 24.239(a) and (i), the deadline for Commission action is one hundred twenty (120) days after the mailing or publication of notice, whichever occurs later. One hundred and twenty days after August 4, 2022 is December 9,2022.
