ITS ENERGY EFFICIENCY COST RECOVERY FACTOR**

**SOAH ORDER NO. 5
ADMITTING EVIDENCE, DISMISSING THE CASE FROM SOAH'S
DOCKET, AND REMANDING IT TO THE COMMISSION**

On August 26, 2022, CenterPoint Energy Houston Electric, LLC (the Company) filed an Agreed Motion to Admit Evidence and Remand Proceeding (Agreed Motion). The Agreed Motion explained that the parties to this proceeding have entered into a Unanimous Stipulation and Settlement Agreement (Agreement) that resolves all outstanding issues.

Within the time period specified in paragraph J. of Section II of the Agreement, the Company shall file with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) Central Records a clean copy of the tariff to be kept in the Commission's tariff book. The tariff shall be filed in accordance with Texas

Utilities Code § 32.101 and 16 TAC § 25.241(b), (d), and (e). The tariff shall reflect the information required by 16 Texas Administrative Code § 25.241.


Further, the Agreed Motion requests that the following materials be admitted into the evidentiary record of this proceeding:

- a. The Company's Application, which includes the direct testimony, exhibits, and workpapers of Shea A. Richardson and Marvin D. Vaughn;
- b. The first errata to the direct testimony of Marvin D. Vaughn;
- c. The Company's Proof of Notice (affidavit of Joyce Johnson-Clark);
- d. Commission Staff's testimony supporting the Agreement and the reasonableness of The Company's, Gulf Coast Coalition of Cities' (GCCC), and the City of Houston's 2021 EECRF rate case expenses (filed on September 20, 2022); and
- e. The Agreement with its attachments.

The Agreement includes as Attachment A a Proposed Order. As soon as practicable, the Company **SHALL** e-mail a Word version of the proposed order to the Commission at cadmorders@puc.texas.gov.

As demonstrated by the Agreement, there are no disputed issues and no hearing is required in this proceeding. Therefore, the Agreed Motion is **GRANTED**, the above exhibits are **ADMITTED**, and this case is **DISMISSED** from the docket of the State Office of Administrative Hearings and **REMANDED** to the Commission for consideration of the Proposed Order.
