AGREED MOTION TO ABATE PROCEEDING


On behalf of the parties to this proceeding, AEP Texas Inc. moves to abate this proceeding because the parties have reached a settlement in principle that resolves all outstanding issues in this docket.¹ The parties seek abatement to allow time to draft and finalize the settlement documents without simultaneously continuing litigation. AEP Texas is authorized to represent that the parties agree to the relief requested in this motion. The parties intend to file settlement documents or, if the documents are not finalized, a status report by September 6, 2022. AEP Texas respectfully requests the administrative law judge enter an order granting this unopposed motion to abate.


