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
**SOAH ORDER NO. 3**  
**GRANTING MOTION TO ABATE**

On August 3, 2022, AEP Texas Inc. (AEP Texas) filed an Agreed Motion to Abate Proceeding on behalf of itself and the Cities Served by AEP Texas Inc., Texas Energy Association for Marketers, and the Alliance for Retail Markets (collectively, the Parties). The Parties indicated they reached a settlement in principle that resolves all outstanding issues in this proceeding and request abatement to allow time to finalize settlement documents. The Parties also indicated they will file settlement documents or a status report by September 6, 2022.

The Administrative Law Judge finds the Parties' unopposed request for abatement has merit and it is **GRANTED**. This proceeding is **ABATED** until otherwise ordered, and the Parties **SHALL** file, **no later than September 6, 2022**, either a complete settlement package and motion for remand or a status update. Consequently, the currently set September 16, 2022 hearing on the merits is **CANCELED**.
