**ORDER NO. 2  
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE  
AND ESTABLISHING OPPORTUNITY TO CURE**

This Order addresses the June 6, 2022 application of SP Utility Company, Inc. for a class D rate adjustment for the Johnson Water Service/Oleander Road Mobile Home Development under its certificate of convenience and necessity number 12978. On July 7, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation that the application be found administratively incomplete and that SP Utility have an opportunity to cure the deficiencies.

The administrative law judge finds the application administratively incomplete. By July 21, 2022, SP Utility must file the additional information to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 7, 2022 memorandum of Kathryn Eiland. By August 4, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation on sufficiency of the application and notice, and propose a procedural schedule, if appropriate.
