ORDER NO. 4 FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY INCOMPLETE AND ESTABLISHING AN OPPORTUNITY TO CURE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the June 13, 2022 application of CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company and George Fuller, executor of the estate of Virginia Fuller, for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Tarrant County. CSWR-Texas filed supplemental information on June 14, 20, and 27, 2022.

On August 1, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation on administrative completeness.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application administratively incomplete and deficient. Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.8(d), the Commission does not consider an application filed until it makes a determination that the application is administratively complete. Thus, at this time the application is not considered filed with the Commission.

By September 1, 2022, the applicants must supplement the application to cure the deficiencies as described in the July 27, 2022 memorandum of James Harville and in the July 27, 2022 memorandum Ethan Blanchard and Kathryn Eiland. Until the Commission receives and reviews the supplemental information, the application cannot proceed. The applicants must not issue notice until the application is deemed administratively complete.

By October 3, 2022, Commission Staff must file a supplemental recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application, along with a proposed procedural schedule, if appropriate.
