ORDER NO. 5
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE, AND RESTYLING DOCKET

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the June 13, 2022 application of CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company and George Fuller, executor of the estate of Virginia Fuller for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. On June 14, 20, and 27, August 16, and September 1, 2022 the applicants supplemented the application.

On October 3, 2022, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application in the manner described in the October 3, 2022 memorandum of James Harville, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation of the same date, using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Event	Date
Deadline for the applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with copies of the notices sent to the affected parties	November 3, 2022
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	November 14, 2022
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued

Additionally, the ALJ restyles this docket as reflected in this Order.
