The requested area includes <u>44</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>4.2</u> mile(s) <u>northeast</u> of downtown <u>Lubbock</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>approximately 780 feet north of East Ursuline Street</u>; on the east by <u>Idalou Road</u>; on the south by <u>United States Highway 62</u>; and on the west by <u>North Redwood Avenue</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>193</u> acres of transferred area from CCN No. 20743 to CCN No. 21120.

You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.




