CSWR-TEXAS UTILITY OPERATING COMPANY, LLC'S RESPONSE TO ORDER NO. 12 AND AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE

CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC ("CSWR-Texas" or "the Company") files this Response to Order No. 12. Order No. 12 directed CSWR-Texas to provide clarification regarding notice to landowners with tracts of land at least 25 acres. CSWR-Texas has reviewed the area proposed to be certified in this case along with the Lubbock County tax appraisal maps and determined that there are three parcels of land at least 25 acres that are wholly or partially included in the proposed area. Per Order No. 12, CSWR-Texas submits the attached supplemental notice affidavit which confirms notice has been sent to the landowners of the three tracts. Attached to the supplemental notice affidavit is a copy of the notice sent to the landowners (Exhibit A), and a mailing list that identifies the landowners (Exhibit B).

CSWR-Texas also provides the following statement of confidentiality. The undersigned attorney has reviewed confidential mailing list attached to the supplemental notice affidavit and confirms that the attachment contains customer-specific information including names and addresses. This information is specifically protected by Tex. Util. Code § 182.052 and is expressly protected under Paragraph 6 of the Commission's standard protective order. Accordingly, the information contained in the confidential attachment is exempt from public disclosure under Tex. Gov't Code § 552.101 and Tex. Util. Code 182.052 and merits the Highly Sensitive Protected Materials designation.



The requested area includes <u>44</u> customer connections, is located approximately <u>4.2</u> mile(s) <u>northeast</u> of downtown <u>Lubbock</u>, Texas, and is generally bounded on the north by <u>approximately</u> <u>780 feet north of East Ursuline Street</u>; on the east by <u>Idalou Road</u>; on the south by <u>United States Highway 62</u>; and on the west by <u>North Redwood Avenue</u>.

The requested area includes approximately <u>193</u> acres of transferred area from CCN No. 20743 to CCN No. 21120.

The application proposes the subtraction of approximately <u>193</u> acres from CCN No. 20743 and the addition of approximately 193 acres to CCN No. 21120.

You must send a letter requesting intervention to the commission which is received by that date. The letter must include the person's name, address, email address and fax number if applicable.

If a valid public hearing is requested, the Commission will forward the application to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) for a hearing. If no settlement is reached and an evidentiary hearing is held, SOAH will submit a recommendation to the Commission for final decision. An evidentiary hearing is a legal proceeding similar to a civil trial in state district court.




