**ORDER NO. 14**  
**FINDING SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE SUFFICIENT**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the supplemental notice provided by CSWR-Texas Utility Operating Company, LLC.

On June 16, 2023, CSWR-Texas filed the supplemental affidavit of Aaron Silas, director of regulatory operations, attesting that notice was provided to each owner of a tract of land that is at least 25 acres and is wholly or partially included in the requested area on June 15, 2023.

On June 27, 2023, CSWR-Texas filed the second supplemental affidavit of Mr. Silas attesting that the supplemental notice provided on June 15, 2023, was mailed via first class mail.

On July 7, 2023, Commission Staff filed its recommendation on sufficiency of supplemental notice.

The administrative law judge finds the supplemental notice sufficient.
