ENTERGY TEXAS, INC.'S REQUEST FOR RULING ON EIGHTEENTH PETITION FOR REVIEW OF MUNICIPAL ORDINANCES AND MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

Entergy Texas, Inc. ("ETI") respectfully files this request for a ruling and in support of its request states the following:

I. REQUEST FOR RULING

On March 3, 2023, ETI filed its Eighteenth Petition for Review of Municipal Ordinances and Motion to Consolidate (Interchange Item No. 492) ("Eighteenth Petition and Motion"), requesting that the Commission exercise its appellate jurisdiction to conduct a de novo review of the municipal actions denying ETI's Application in this proceeding, consolidate this appeal with Docket No. 53719, and establish the final rates that the cities would have set by approving ETI's Application.¹

All of the municipalities in ETI's service area have denied ETI's Application. ETI has previously filed petitions for review and motions to consolidate the petitions of review related to those municipal actions, which were granted by State Office of Administrative Hearings ("SOAH") Orders.² ETI's Eighteenth Petition and Motion is the last petition for review and motion to consolidate.

On May 31, 2023, the Office of Policy and Docket Management ("OPDM") filed a Memorandum noting that the evidentiary record does not appear to contain the presiding officer's ruling on ETI's Eighteenth Petition and Motion.³ Upon review, ETI concurs with OPDM, and respectfully requests the entry of a SOAH Order addressing ETI's Eighteenth Petition and Motion.

II. CONCLUSION

ETI respectfully requests the SOAH Administrative Law Judges rule on the Eighteenth Petition and Motion before June 5, 2023, consistent with the deadline requested in OPDM's Memorandum.
