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**ORDER NO. 1**  
**GRANTING EIGHTEENTH PETITION FOR REVIEW AND**  
**CONSOLIDATING MUNICIPAL APPEALS**

This Order addresses the March 3, 2023 eighteenth petition for review of municipal ordinances and motion to consolidate filed by Entergy Texas, Inc. On June 5, 2023, following a partial remand of this case from the State Office of Administrative Hearings, Entergy Texas re-urged its eighteenth petition for review of municipal ordinances and motion to consolidate. Entergy Texas states that the cities of Oak Ridge North and Shepherd (collectively, Cities) denied Entergy Texas's requested rate change. In its petition, Entergy Texas appeals the Cities' decisions and requests that the appeals be consolidated with this docket to promote regulatory efficiency, stating that the appeals involve common questions of law and fact to those in this proceeding.

No objections were filed. Entergy Texas's eighteenth petition is granted and the appeals of the Cities' denials are consolidated for review with this proceeding.
