Subject: Entergy Texas, Inc. - July 1, 2022 Statement of Intent and Application for Authority to Change Rates.

Entergy has requested your approval to increase Residential rates for the homes of approximately 422,815 Texas citizens. They propose to increase CHANGE IN NON-FUEL REVENUES +13.68% and a CHANGE IN TOTAL REVENUES +9.84% for residential customers. Based on their total proposal for all rate classes they plan to increase their income from non-fuel to \$1.2 billion per year – an increase of \$131.4 million or 11.2%

We oppose this request to change rates and believe if approved it will result in financial hardships on the citizens of Southeast Texas. In this part of Texas we are locked into electrical service from Entergy. They have a monopoly granted by the State and are the only choice for electrical service here. A 10% increase in residential electrical costs would impose an unfair burden – particularly the low income and retired citizens on a fixed income.

We request that you deny Entergy's request for Authority to Change Rates.
