Application for Sale, Transfer, or Merger of a Retail Public Utility

Pursuant to Texas Water Code § 13.301 and 16 Texas Administrative Code § 24.109

Sale, Transfer, or Merger (STM) Application Instructions

- . **COMPLETE**: In order for the Commission to find the application sufficient for filing, the Applicant should:
 - i. Provide an answer to every question and submit any required attachment applicable to the STM request (i.e., agreements or contracts).
 - ii. Use attachments or additional pages to answer questions as necessary. If you use attachments or additional pages, reference their inclusion in the form.
 - iii. Provide all mapping information as detailed in Part G: Mapping & Affidavits.
- II. **FILE**: Seven (7) copies of the completed application with numbered attachments. One copy should be filed with no permanent binding, staples, tabs, or separators; and 7 copies of the portable electronic storage medium containing the digital mapping data.
 - i. <u>SEND TO</u>: Public Utility Commission of Texas, Attention: Filing Clerk, 1701 N. Congress Avenue, P.O. Box 13326, Austin, Texas 78711-3326 (NOTE: Electronic documents may be sent in advance of the paper copy, however they will not be processed and added to the Commission's on-line Interchange until the paper copy is received and file-stamped in Central Records).
- III. The application will be assigned a docket number, and an administrative law judge (ALJ) will issue an order requiring Commission Staff to file a recommendation on whether the application is sufficient. The ALJ will issue an order after Staff's recommendation has been filed:
 - i. <u>DEFICIENT (Administratively Incomplete):</u> Applicants will be ordered to provide information to cure the deficiencies by a certain date, usually 30 days from ALJ's order. *Application is not accepted for filing*.
 - ii. <u>SUFFICIENT (Administratively Complete):</u> Applicants will be ordered by the ALJ to give appropriate notice of the application using the notice prepared by Commission Staff. *Application is accepted for filing*.
- IV. Once the Applicants issue notice, a copy of the actual notice sent and an affidavit attesting to notice should be filed in the docket assigned to the application. Recipients of notice may request a hearing on the merits.

HEARING ON THE MERITS: An affected party may request a hearing within 30 days of notice. In this event, the application may be referred to the State Office of Administrative Hearings (SOAH) to complete this request.

- V. **TRANSACTION TO PROCEED**: at any time following the provision of notice, or prior to 120 days from the last date that proper notice was given, Commission Staff will file a recommendation for the transaction to proceed as proposed or recommend that the STM be referred to SOAH for further investigation. The Applicants will be required to file an <u>update in the docket to the ALJ every 30 days</u> following the approval of the transaction. The <u>transaction must be completed within six (6) months from the ALJ's order</u> (Note: The Applicants may request an extension to the 6 month provision for good cause).
- VI. **FILE**: Seven (7) copies of completed transaction documents and documentation addressing the transfer or disposition of any outstanding deposits. After receiving all required documents from the Applicants, the application will be granted a procedural schedule for final processing. The Applicants are requested to consent in writing to the proposed maps and certificates, or tariff if applicable.
- VII. **FINAL ORDER:** The ALJ will issue a final order issuing or amending the applicable CCNs.



INTRODUCTION

A routine Comprehensive Compliance Investigation (CCI) was conducted at Crystal Systems (PWS ID No. 2120015, CCN No. 10804) on 03/26/2020. The CCI began at the office, located at the Fair Building at 225 S. College Street, Tyler (Smith Co.), Texas. The participants included Mr. James Sellars, Field Superintendent (903-592-8509, mobile 903-574-5127) and Ms. Kathy Baker, Office Manager and Secretary/Treasurer (903-574-1052). Ms. Baker received prior notification by telephone and email of the investigation on 03/12/2020. An exit interview was conducted with Mr. Sellars on 03/26/2020.

This PWS investigation was conducted during the COVID-19 pandemic to ensure public access to safe drinking water. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) best management practices were used during the investigation, which included social distancing.

GENERAL FACILITY AND PROCESS INFORMATION

Crystal Systems is a community groundwater system with four main plants and a small booster plant which mainly serve the incorporated community of Hideaway and a few connections adjacent to it. Supply source Carrizo Wilcox Aquifer.

Plants 3, 4, 5, and 6 each consist of one well with vertical turbine pump and meter, sodium tripolyphosphate for sequestering iron, a sand separator, gas chlorination, and distribution. At Plants 3 and 4, after the aforementioned treatments, the water flows directly into the distribution system (the wells at these plants are included in the service pump calculations). At Plants 5 and 6, ground storage tanks and service pumps are utilized. Wells 6, 7, 8, and 9 are associated with these plants, respectively.

Plant 2 also includes the same treatment capabilities as the other plants, but the Well 5 has been out of service and is not listed in Texas Drinking Water Watch. Therefore, Plant 2 is excluded from the capacity calculations.

The water system is normally operated with two separate pressure planes, the main pressure plane and the Indian Hills pressure plane. Two elevated storage tanks (ESTs) float together to serve the main plane, which includes Hideaway. A booster station, located adjacent to the West EST, with pressure tanks and service pumps, serve the Indian Hills pressure plane, which is relatively higher in elevation than the main pressure plane.

At the time of this investigation, there was no outstanding violation issued by the TCEO Tyler Region Office.

Crystal System's response to the 2 issues mentioned in the report are as follows:

- 1. Crystal Systems has updated its Drought Contingency Plan which is now posted a draft on its website for comment. Further, Crystal has contacted the City of Hideaway and Hide-A-Way Lake, Club Inc; and notice to review on the draft plan will go out to all customers this week with the normal monthly billing asking for comments.
- 2. Crystal Systems Well #5 last produced on July 14, 2019 before experiencing down hole issues. An initial investigation has yielded no clear evidence of the nature and scale of the problem. Due to a pending expense requiring Crystal to relocate 11,000 feet of water main along FM-16 for widening this summer, Management has elected to defer expending additional funds on the well until the relocation project is completed and an economic assessment can be made.






