ORDER NO. 7
FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING
NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses Commission Staff's November 16, 2022 recommendations regarding the July 1, 2022 application of Crystal Systems Texas, LLC and Undine Texas, LLC for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Smith County. The application was found to be administratively incomplete and deficient in Order No. 4, filed on September 12, 2022. The applicants supplemented the application on September 12, 14, 16, 21, and 22, October 6 and 31, and November 9, 2022.

On November 16, 2022, Commission Staff filed a supplemental recommendation that the application be found administratively complete and that the applicants be instructed to proceed with providing notice.

The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application in the manner described in the November 16, 2022 memorandum of Patricia Garcia, attached to Commission Staff's recommendation, and using the included forms.

The ALJ adopts the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for the applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties and published in a newspaper of general circulation	January 3, 2023
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice	January 13, 2023
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
