**COMMISSION STAFF’S REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

On July 6, 2022, Crystal Systems Texas, LLC (Crystal Systems) and Undine Texas, LLC (Undine) (jointly, Applicants) filed an application for approval of the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate of convenience and necessity (CCN) rights in Smith County. Applicants seek approval to sell and transfer Crystal System’s facilities and all of Crystal System’s certificated area under CCN No. 10804 to Undine.

On November 17, 2022, the administrative law judge filed Order No. 7, establishing a deadline of January 13, 2023, for the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice.

**I. REQUEST FOR EXTENSION**

Under 16 Texas Administrative Code § 22.4(b), a party may request that the time allowed for the filing of any documents be extended for good cause. After reviewing Undine’s notice, Staff noticed an issue with Undine’s notice that Undine has agreed to correct. Accordingly, Staff requests that its deadline to file a recommendation on the sufficiency of notice be extended to February 13, 2023, to give Undine sufficient time to address Staff’s concern. Staff has conferred with counsel for Undine and is authorized to represent Undine is unopposed with the proposed extension.

**II. CONCLUSION**

Staff respectfully requests the entry of an order extending Staff’s deadline to February 13, 2023, to file its recommendation on the sufficiency of notice.
