FINDING NOTICE SUFFICIENT AND SOLICITING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the notice provided by Crystal Systems Texas, LLC and Undine Texas, LLC of this application for the sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Smith County. On December 5, 2022, Undine Texas provided an affidavit dated December 2, 2022, and signed by Carey A. Thomas, Undine Texas' senior vice president, that notice was mailed on December 2, 2022, to its current customers, landowners, neighboring utilities, and affected parties, with maps. Undine Texas also provided copies of its publication and a publisher's affidavit dated January 23, 2023, showing that notice was published in the *Tyler Morning Telegraph*, a newspaper of general circulation in Smith County, on November 23 and 30, 2022.


On February 13, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the sufficiency of notice.
