
**ORDER NO. 9  
ABATING PROCEEDING**

This Order addresses the joint request for abatement filed by Nitsch and Son Utility Company, Inc., Undine Texas, LLC, and Commission Staff on March 24, 2023. The parties stated that the request for consent from the City of Houston to allow Undine to provide service inside the city limits is still pending, and abatement of this proceeding is appropriate.

The administrative law judge abates this proceeding. Any party may file a request to lift the abatement. Commission Staff must propose a procedural schedule for processing concurrently with the request to lift the abatement. The parties are required to file a status report every 60 days.
