#### COMMISSION STAFF AND APPLICANTS' JOINT MOTION TO LIFT ABATEMENT

COMES NOW, Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) and Nitsch and Son Utility Company, Inc. (Nitsch) and Undine Texas, LLC (Undine) (Applicants), and files this their Joint Motion to Lift Abatement and would show the ALJ as follows:

#### I. BACKGROUND

On July 14, 2022, Nitsch and Son Utility Company, Inc. (Nitsch) and Undine Texas, LLC (Undine) (collectively, the "Applicants") filed with the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission) an application for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County, Texas. Undine filed supplemental information on September 15 and 22, October 6, and November 9 and 10, 2022.

On March 24, 2023, Applicants and Staff (the "Parties") requested an abatement of this proceeding pending consent from the City of Houston to allow Undine to provide service inside the city limits, which request was before the City.

On March 28, 2023, the assigned ALJ issued an Order abating this proceeding.

#### II. MOTION TO LIFT ABATEMENT

The Parties have conferred and agree that it is appropriate to continue the processing of this application (i.e., deem the application administratively complete) while the City of Houston consent remains pending and lift the abatement.

Attached as Exhibit A is correspondence between the Applicants and the City of Houston reflecting discussions between the two parties. The Applicants are confident based on their discussions with the City of Houston representatives that the Applicants are making progress in obtaining the consent of the City of Houston. Consequently, the Parties agree that the lifting of the abatement and continuing the processing of this application is in the Parties interest. To that end, Parties agree that Staff will submit a supplemental recommendation on administrative completeness and notice and proposed procedural schedule by May 6, 2023

#### III. CONCLUSION

As detailed above, Staff and Applicants respectfully request an order lifting the abatement in this proceeding. The undersigned counsel for Undine files this motion with the consent of Nitsch.






