**ORDER NO. 11**  
**FINDING APPLICATION ADMINISTRATIVELY COMPLETE, REQUIRING**  
**NOTICE, AND ESTABLISHING A PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

This Order addresses the sufficiency of the July 14, 2022 application of Undine Texas, LLC and Nitsch and Son Utility Company, Inc. for sale, transfer, or merger of facilities and certificate rights in Harris County. Undine Texas supplemented the application on July 25, September 15 and 22, October 6, and November 9 and 10, 2022, and January 31, 2023.

On May 8, 2023, Commission Staff filed a recommendation regarding the administrative completeness of the application and notice.


The administrative law judge (ALJ) finds the application, as supplemented, administratively complete and directs the applicants to provide notice of the application and proof of notice in the manner described in the May 8, 2023 memorandum of Patricia Garcia using the forms attached to Commission Staff's recommendation of the same date.

The ALJ establishes the following procedural schedule:

Deadline for the applicants to file with the Commission signed affidavits that the notice was given along with a copy of the notice and map sent to the affected parties	June 22, 2023
Deadline for Commission Staff to file a recommendation on sufficiency of notice and propose a procedural schedule for continued processing	July 5, 2023
Deadline to intervene	30 days after notice is issued
