**JOINT CLARIFICATION**

On November 8, 2024, the administrative law judge (ALJ) issued Order No. 30 Requiring Clarification, which established a deadline of November 15, 2024 for Undine Texas, LLC (Undine), Nitsch and Son Utility Company (Nitsch), and the Staff (Staff) of the Public Utility Commission of Texas (Commission), (collectively, the Parties) to respond. Therefore, this pleading is timely filed.


